

Transparency in Coverage

The Transparency in Coverage Final Rules (the TIC Final Rules), which are a provision of the Affordable Care Act, require health insurance issuers offering coverage to disclose on a public website, information regarding in-network provider rates for covered items and services, out-of-network allowed amounts and billed charges for covered items and services, and negotiated rates and historical net prices for covered prescription drugs in three separate machine-readable files.

Beginning July 1, PVARF's health insurance provider Kaiser Permanente will publish the MRFs for the plans they administer and maintain. The files will be made public for plan years that begin on or after January 1, 2022 and will be refreshed monthly.
